### Minister for Children, Young People and Families visits Peace Centre

On Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January the Minister for Children, Young People and Families, The Rt. Hon Beverley Hughes MP, will visit the charity created after the death of two young boys in an IRA attack on Warrington.

Based in Warrington, the Trust delivers unique flexible courses which give young people the opportunity to understand the impact their behaviour and attitude can have on themselves and others.

The Minister takes an overview of all policies for children, young people and families and previously was Minister of State for Immigration, Citizenship and Counter – Terrorism. She has been Member of Parliament for Stretford and Urmston since 1997.
